HEADLINES FOR FULL GOVERNORS:

- The three areas that were looked at by OFSTED during their recent visit were: Communication across the school, Creative Arts and PSE
- OFSTED Inspectors thoroughly investigated the Curriculum by talking to Subject Leaders, looking through pupil files and evidence that showed the quality of each subject
- A detailed report will be supplied by HB at the next full GB meeting
- Pupil Progress – Outstanding progress would be measured using individualised targets met, with 95% of targets met being outstanding progress
- Students not making expected progress can be identified and discussions can be had with teachers on a more individualised level
- Pupil progress meeting will take place in January 2020 and also in April 2020
- Due to changes in the OFSTED framework and the recommendation to reduce workload, GM asked governors how they would like pupil progress data to be presented to them
- Parental Engagement – Parent workshops to continue during the next academic year. Kathryn Connor to lead on this.
- School is exploring the 'Leading Parent Partnership Award'. This is a Kitemark Award which recognises collaborative, effective work with parents.
- Target setting and Assessment - GM gave a new English and Maths Learning Outcomes target document to all governors.
- The complaints policy has been updated and been made a trust wide complaints policy.
