Current After School and Holiday Clubs

Chatsworth High School and Community College currently run 5 Extended Schools Clubs:

Chatsworth Youth Group – every Monday, 3:30pm to 5:30pm, term time only
Sports Club - every Thursday, 3:30pm to 5:30pm, term time only
Lets Get Cooking - every Wednesday, 3:30pm to 5:45pm, term time only
Saturday Club - every Saturday, 10:00am to 2:30pm, term time only
Summer Scheme – first 2 weeks of summer holidays

Charges and fees

Chatsworth High School and Community College charges session fees for each session that the child attends at each club. The fees are reviewed annually.

- Parents/carers are liable for all sessions regardless of attendance
- Payment should be made for each club half termly in advance to assist cash flow
- Payments can be made through cash or cheque – cheque payments should be made payable to Chatsworth High School and Community College
- All fees must be paid for the upcoming half term in advance unless otherwise agreed in writing by the school
- Current charges are as follows:
